
Care for patients with fibrodysplasia ossificans progressiva (FOP) requires many medical specialties and a coordinated, multidisciplinary approach is essential for high-quality patient care.¹

A patient's multidisciplinary care network should be coordinated by their primary care physician (PCP). The PCP is responsible for organizing a local team of specialists without expertise in FOP and consulting with FOP experts where necessary.¹

This infographic explains the roles that different specialists play within the care network. The core care network consists of specialties that may see the patient on a regular basis, while the expanded care network are those that may be required on an ad hoc basis.
